# Partial Solar Eclipse

## Thursday October 23

- Eclipse may be safely viewed from Campus Observatory.
- Eclipse begins at 2:53 PM
- Maximum Eclipse at 4:13 PM  
(72% of diameter eclipsed by moon)



- Do NOT look at Sun without proper eclipse glasses!
